2.1 Description of the company

Fuelwood Group Sweden AB is a pellet production and sales company with a pellet plant located in the Mid-Eastern side of Sweden in Söderhamn. The company was founded in 2017 by a group of Estonian entrepreneurs. Pellet production started in 2019. By now Fuelwood Group Sweden produces wood pellets from processing residues (sawdust, shavings, chips). Relatively small company. Pellet production capacity is around 50 000 tons a year. The production plant is run by a small team of 5 employees. As well the processing steps are quite simple. The production mainly is ran by external electricity (conveyor, hammermill, pellet press) and heat (for feedstock drying) provided by local suppliers, also 2 wheel loaders used for feedstock handling. By now there is only one feedstock supplier, which is also wood processor located in Sweden, FSC certified organization. The feedstock is delivered by trucks. Pellets are delivered by trucks to closest port (Stangskärvägen 10, Sandarne, 82022, Sweden) and sold at closest port Stangskärvägen10, Sandarne, 82022 on FOB incoterms, by now single client in Denmark.

2.2 Detailed description of the Chain of Custody system

Organization holds valid FSC COC certificate. All feedstock used for biomass production is FSC certified. By now source only pine and spruce sawdust and shavings from single supplier in Sweden. Receive feedstock by trucks according to agreement with supplier. During production of biomass there is no risk of mixing with non-eligible input. Maintain credit system for control of biomass/pellets volumes. All feedstock is also eligible for NL category 5, for which credit account maintained. Sell pellets on FOB incoterms, by now to single customer in Denmark.

3 Specific objective

The specific objective of this evaluation was to confirm that the Biomass Producer have addressed Major non-conformity.

Weighted average load of received shavings not recorded in the SAR, however data available from accounting system; not correct electricity use calculation per metric ton; not recorded information on biomass fuel use for heat production from conventional boiler for drying.

Recorded weighted average truck load of received shavings (22 mt), correctly calculated electricity use per metric ton of pellet production (3738219kWh / 20066mt=186,3 kWh/mt); recorded total biomass fuel use (7925,46 mt) calculated from total heat produced by conventional boiler (16801,97 MWh) and average net calorific value (2,12 MWh/mt according to AEOBIUM Wood fuels handbook) of wood at 52% moisture content (16801,97/2,12 = 7925,46 mt).
